- What is the book about? (don't give away any surprise endings or unexpected plot twists!)
- What type of book is it? (non-fiction, fiction, animal story, adventure story, mystery etc)
- Who is your favourite character? Why?
- In your opinion, what is the best part of the book? Why?
- Who else do you think would like this book? (age groups, people with certain interests etc)
- How many stars would you give this book? (5 out of 5 for example)
