Success Criteria
I can structure my writing clearly, including having an introduction (which states what the argument is about) and a conclusion (which summarises the topic).
I use formal language consistently throughout my work.
I use adding connectives such as 'in addition', 'moreover', 'furthermore' and 'additionally'.
I use causal connectives such as 'because', 'due to the fact' and 'consequently'.
I can use rhetorical questions.
I can use ambitious vocabulary which is appropriate to the text (e.g. emotive adjectives)
I can include facts and statistics in my writing.
I can vary my sentence lengths; short for effect and long for description.
I can use repetition for emphasis
