



Are you worried about bullying?

Our school has a zero-tolerance approach to peer-on-peer abuse such as bullying. Because of our dedication to our values of friendship and respect, bullying is extremely rare. However, we know how important it is to remember that bullying can begin at any time and might not always be easy to spot.



SPEAK UP - Be brave and make sure adults know if you or your friend are experiencing bullying. *If you are a parent with a concern, ask to speak to the class teacher straight away.*

WHAT WILL HAPPEN? – We take all information about bullying very seriously. Teachers at the school will work together with the children, parents and other school staff to understand the situation and then choose the right thing to do.

MOVING FORWARD – Any victims of bullying will receive support to make sure they enjoy a happy and positive time at our school. There will be significant consequences for anyone who has bullied another person, including work with parents/carers and a plan to ensure it does not happen again.
