Safer Internet Day Tuesday 10th February 2026

At Brixington Primary Academy, Safer Internet Day is an opportunity to help children use the internet safely, confidently and responsibly.

What children are learning in school

- * How to recognise unsafe or worrying online content.
- * Why not everything online is true or trustworthy.
- * The importance of telling a trusted adult if something online makes them uncomfortable.

How parents can help at home

- * Talk regularly about what your child does online.
- * Encourage them to tell you if something worries them.
- * Remind them never to share personal information.
- * Set clear, age-appropriate boundaries for screen use.

Our key message to children

--STOP – THINK – TELL--

If something online feels wrong:

- * Stop and don't reply
- * Think about whether it is safe or kind
- * Tell a trusted adult straight away

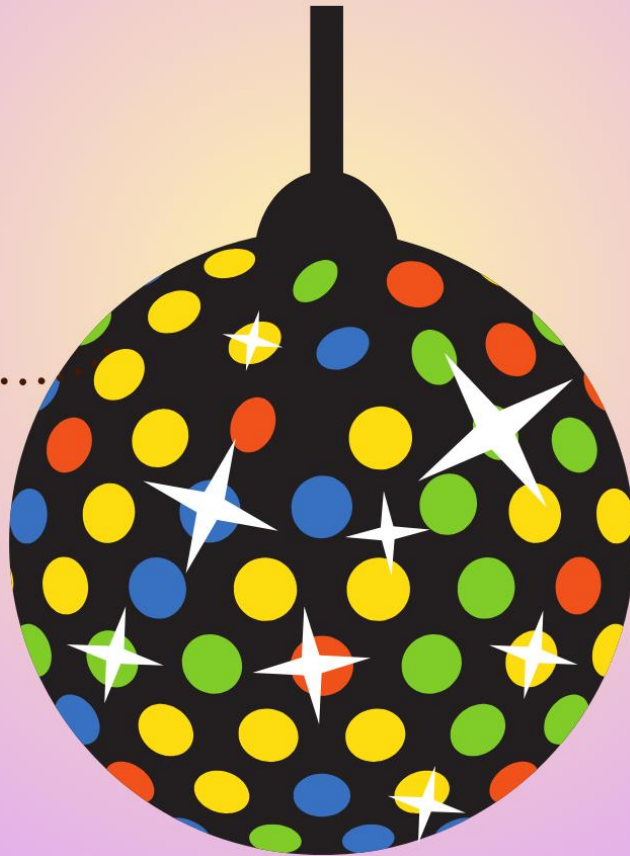

Seachange in Budleigh Salterton, the local health and wellbeing hub, want to share news of an exciting story writing competition for children aged 6-11 that they are running this spring.

Seachange have been lucky to get support from The World of Country Life in Exmouth who have kindly donated a full day's pass as well as local writer Chris Marriott who has donated copies of his book.

The competition launch will appear in the inaugural issue of their charity magazine published in March 2026 and on social media. They would love to involve local schools, the emphasis is very much on enjoyment, imagination and participation – we can't wait to read what the students write!

About the competition

- Who for? children aged 6-11
- What? A short story inspired by 'Appy Angus, the World of Country Life mascot and Godfrey the Seagull. You can find out more about 'Appy Angus at [World of Country Life - World of Country Life](#) and you can see more about Godfrey and his friends at www.seachangedevon.org
 - When: Writing can take place during March - April 2026
 - Deadline: 16th April 2026 – a week after the Easter holidays
- Outcome: The winning story will be published in our Autumn 2026 charity magazine, with first prize of a full day's pass at World of Country Life, a copy of local writer and artist Chris Marriott's new book 'Surfing the Stars' and second and third prizes to include mini Angus' and Godfreys as well as other goody bag gifts! There will also be recognition for the winners of 1st, 2nd and 3rd prizes (should they want it) and their schools on social media.

Possible suggestions for story ideas:

- 'Appy Angus meets Godfrey the Seagull and they make friends – what mischief do they get up to?
- Godfrey helps Angus out of a problem – or the other way round - and saves the day.
 - Consider the Seachange themes of social connection, mental wellbeing, health and friendship and write a story about 'Appy Angus and Godfrey based on one of those. You may want to research about them and how Seachange promotes wellbeing at our website together as a class: www.seachangedevon.org
- 'Appy Angus visits Seachange – maybe he goes to the gym or takes part in an exercise class and gets into all sorts of trouble!
 - You could continue this story: "Godfrey had just settled down in the café for his favourite drink (of??) when a great clattering sounded outside..."
 - Explain, in the style of a creation story, how a Red Deer became green or how the seagull got a yellow beak.
